PROBLEM:

I wanted to play around with the old net send command, but it seems that in vista / 7 it has been replaced by msg.exe

typing

```
msg /PCNAME TEXT
```

gave the **does not exist or is disconnected** error.

HOWTO:

After a while i found out it had to be

```
msg /SERVER:PCNAME USERNAME TEXT
```

example : msg /server:desktop2 tom hello world!

msg .exe (net send) in windows vista / 7 - user does not exist or is disconnected
